AHCPGD206 CONDUCT VISUAL INSPECTION OF PARK FACILITIES

AHCPGD206 Conduct Visual Inspection of Park Facilities offers an entry level into park inspection. It is suited for those undertaking a daily to weekly check of park facilities as part of their normal duties.

This unit will provide participants with the knowledge required to carry out routine visual inspections of park and recreational facilities to identify visible hazards, as well as existing and potential risks.

This unit is aimed at individuals who work under general supervision and exercise limited autonomy with some accountability for their work. They undertake defined activities and work in a structured context. This may include those in a routine maintenance role.

Possible job roles after successful completion of this unit may include:

- Park maintenance personnel.
- Park inspector.

AHCPGD305 CONDUCT OPERATIONAL INSPECTION OF PARK FACILITIES

AHCPGD305 Conduct Operational Inspection of Park Facilities offers an operational level of understanding and experience of park and recreational inspections. It is suited for those undertaking a monthly to quarterly check of park facilities as part of their normal duties.

This unit will provide participants with the skills and knowledge required to inspect park or recreational facilities to identify hazards, existing and potential risks and non-conformities with Australian Standards and workplace health and safety requirements.

This unit is aimed at individuals who take responsibility for their own work and for the quality of the work of others. They use discretion and judgement in the selection, allocation and use of available resources. All work is carried out to comply with workplace procedures. This may include playground operators or those in a supervisory or maintenance role.

Possible job roles after successful completion of this unit may include:

- Park supervisor.
- Park maintenance personnel.
- Park inspector.

AHCPGD505 CONDUCT COMPREHENSIVE INSPECTION OF PARK FACILITIES

AHCPGD505 Conduct Comprehensive Inspection of Park Facilities offers a comprehensive level of experience and understanding of park inspection. It is suited for those undertaking a yearly check of park facilities as part of their normal duties.

This unit will provide individuals with the skills and knowledge required to conduct a compliance audit of park or recreational facilities to identify non-conformities with Australian standards, legislative and work health and safety requirements, as well as manufacturers' standards. It has been specially designed to incorporate both the AHCPGD206 Conduct Visual Inspection of Park Facilities and AHCPGD305 Conduct Operational Inspection of Park Facilities units.

This unit is aimed at those who are responsible for the comprehensive compliance audit of park or recreation facilities. These individuals analyse information and exercise judgement to complete a range of advanced skilled activities and demonstrate deep knowledge in a specific technical area. They have accountability for the work of others and analyse, design and communicate solutions to a range of complex problems. All work is carried out to comply with workplace procedures. This may include playground operators, supervisory and technical personnel, risk assessors, design and safety officers, landscape designers and architects, auditors, equipment installers, managers and owners of a playground in public and private parks, schools, childcare and other recreation and leisure facilities.

Possible job roles after successful completion of this unit may include:

- Park maintenance personnel.
- Park specialists.
- Park supervisor.
